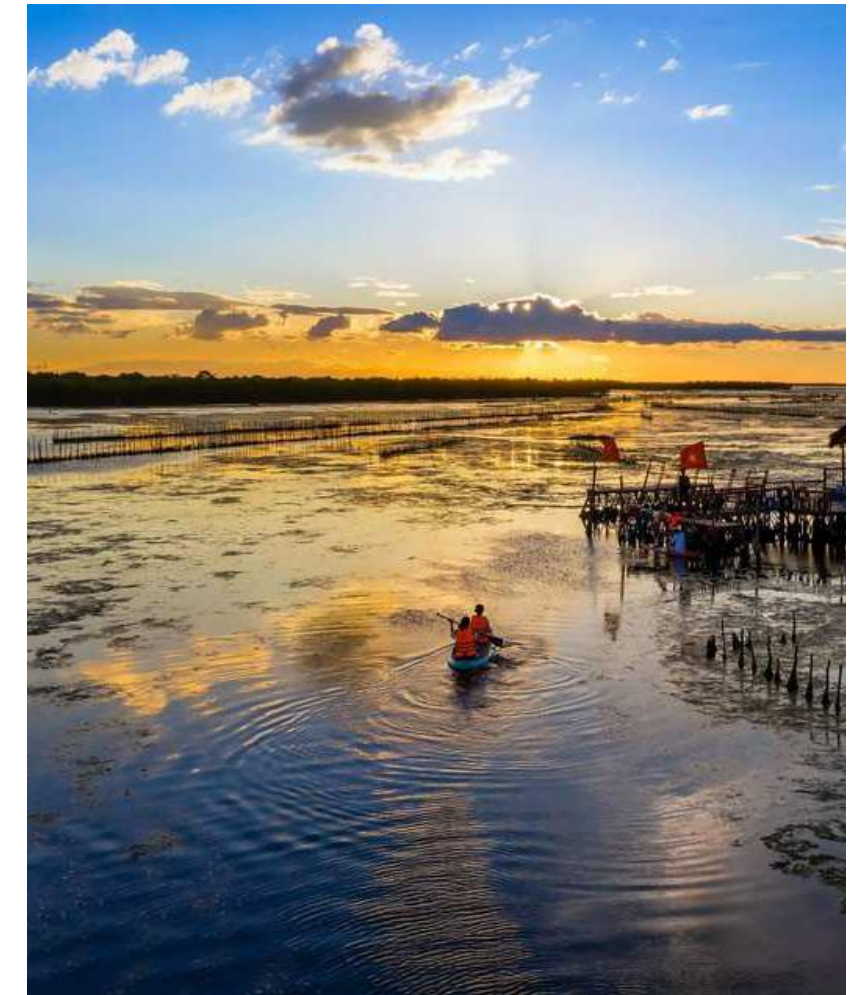

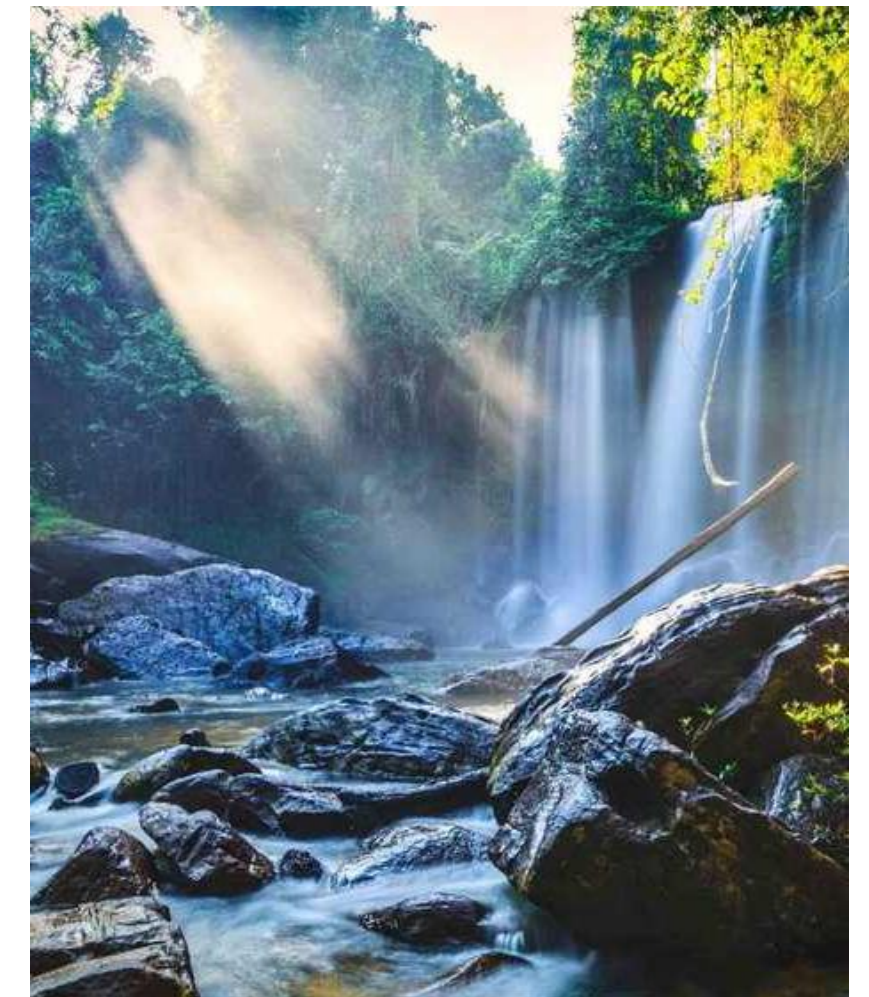

## Missions for a Sustainable Action Plan

- **Reducing Carbon Footprint:** offer guided bike tours, promote train travel for regionals tours.
- **Waste reduction:** provide reusable water bottles and durable bag, organize natural area clean-ups.
- **Supporting Local Communities:** source food from local farms and markets, partner with local cultural centers.
- **Respecting the Environment:** avoid wildlife-disturbing tours, fund local reforestation projects, distribute guidelines on minimizing impacts .
- **Sustainable Office Practices:** go paperless with digital documents
- **Transparency and Education:** include eco-friendly tips in tour briefings, create educational sustainability content.
- **Responsible Resource Management:** implement water conservation at accommodations, use sustainable materials for equipment, develop a long-term plan to preserve tourist sites.
- **Increased Visitor Spending:** promote locally made, eco-friendly products, provide sustainable accommodation options.
