# MEKONG DELTA SHORTBREAK

A short two-hour car transfer delivers you to the pristine natural beauty that is Ben Tre Province. Known as “Coconut Island,” many of its people still rely on tradition and centuries old methods of production. Our program focuses on the Giong Trom district an area untouched by commercial and mass tourism.



We showcase the amazing local people, their daily work, the villages they call home and the peaceful rivers they use as a part of their daily lives. We offer a non-commercial, unfabricated excursion into the Ben Tre area guided by our warm and friendly local team.

Our program includes private car transfer to Ben Tre, two days of private guided touring with local guide, overnight at the beautiful Mango Home Riverside, five course meal presentation throughout - including a cooking class dinner demonstration the first night.



Our program begins with a ride on a motorized cart, where you will board your private day cruiser. Learn about Ben Tre and their most famous export – the Coconut. Discover the many products that are derived from it and the processes involved. Explore a quiet canal full of lush vegetation while rowing slowly through to mouth of the bigger river, where you will rendezvous with your larger day boat and continue your tour. Enjoy a walk through the market, which offers everything from fresh seafood, meat, vegetables and even dry goods and clothing. You will also have a chance to see a family owned shrimp farm. Cycle to Phong Nam village to see a local Cao Dai Temple and learn about their traditions and beliefs.

The third morning is free to relax at our boutique resort with time for self-exploration of our area by bicycle or simply relaxing at the swimming pool. Private car will then return you to HCMC after lunch on day 3.

# LAOS

Often overlooked in favor of its better-known neighbors, landlocked Laos remains one of Southeast Asia's most beguiling destinations.



Mainly mountainous and bisected by the lifegiving Mekong River, separated from Vietnam by the Annamite mountains to the east and by the upper Mekong from Thailand to the west, it's a place with an untouched, almost mystical charm, and visitors are unfailingly captivated by its arresting landscapes and the warmth and humor of its people.

At elevation, hilltribes villages populate waterfall-filled tracts of forest. In lowland capital Luang Prabang, Theravada monks swathed in bright saffron and burnt sienna

robes weave between gilded temples, French colonial homes and traditional wooden houses to collect alms.

On a river trip to the Pak Ou caves to see thousands of Buddha images left by the faithful, you'll pass local fishermen playing out finely-woven nets from bamboo boats and visit silk-weaving villages where local women craft fine scarves bound for the country's atmospheric night markets. You'll can get a feel for Laos in a couple of days, but those that linger longer are richly rewarded.

# CAMBODIA



Despite sharing a border with Vietnam, Cambodia's history and culture is extremely different and this kingdom of color and contrasts confounds and enthralls in equal measure.



There are few sights more breathtaking than seeing the sun rising and setting over the ancient Angkorian temple complex in Siem Reap Province. Here, you can explore the fortified city of Angkor Thom, where 200 huge, carved Bayon faces stare down

from 54 towers, and marvel at jungle-entwined Buddhist temple Ta Prohm, which looks just as it did when French explorers stumbled upon it in the 1860s.

Many visitors choose to linger in Siem Reap but those that visit Phnom Penh are rewarded with insights into Cambodia's past wealth – consider its golden-spined palaces, rambling colonial mansions and striking modern 1950s and 1960s townships and stadia – and a harrowing reminder of how quickly the Khmer Rouge (1975-1979) destroyed it. First visit S 21 – a Khmer Rouge prison, torture and execution

center set within a former school in Tuol Sleng, where mugshots of the thousands of victims that were brought here, many infants, are displayed in chilling black and white. Then take a tuktuk ride out to the killing fields, where the bones of victims protruding from the ground and a stupa of skulls pay chilling tribute to the Cambodian genocide.
